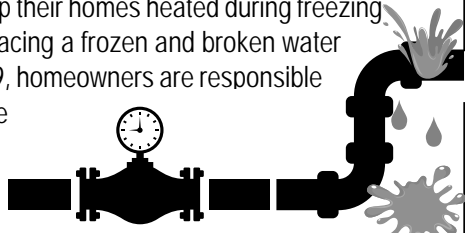


CITY CONNECTIONS- Water Meters and Freezing Temperatures

The City would like to advise residents to keep their homes heated during freezing temperatures to avoid the hefty costs of replacing a frozen and broken water meter. According to City Code Section 3-4-19, homeowners are responsible for the costs of such repairs due to negligence by freezing, hot water or other damage except ordinary wear and tear.

(0° Celsius)

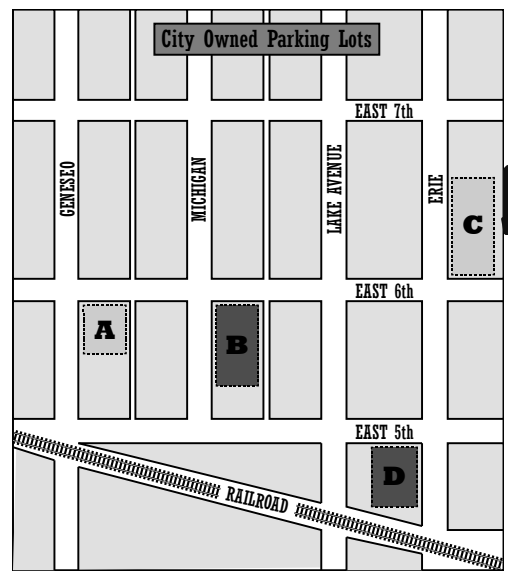


SNOW REMOVAL

A SNOW EMERGENCY means parking is NOT allowed on city streets and parking lots:
From 10PM to 6AM in the residential areas and
From 2AM to 6AM in the commercial areas.

SNOW EMERGENCY PARKING RESTRICTIONS

During a snow emergency, cars cannot be parked on the streets and the following parking restrictions are in place:



- Parking is **NOT ALLOWED** on streets:
 - In residential areas from 10 PM - 6 AM
 - In the Central Business District from 2 AM - 6 AM
- Parking is **NOT ALLOWED** in downtown public parking lots designated as Lot B and Lot D
- Overnight parking **IS ALLOWED** in downtown public parking lots designated as Lot A and Lot C.
