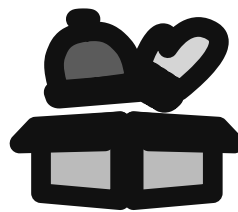


Beginning on **December 23rd 2019 and running through January 10, 2020**
