Tips for residents....

- Parking is prohibited on all streets during a Declared Snow Emergency. Violators may be ticketed and towed. (Details visit www.213snow.com)

- Year-round ordinance that prohibits parking Downtown from 3-6 a.m. (Ordinance 01-O-2019-2020)

- Do not shovel, plow or blow snow into the street. In addition to being illegal, blowing snow in the street makes it difficult to keep roadways clear.

- Keep mailboxes clear to ensure postal delivery.

- Help clear snow and ice around fire hydrants and storm drains

The Storm Lake Fire Department appreciates the help of citizens in removing snow from around fire hydrants in their neighborhood to keep them free for use in times of an emergency. If you are not able to remove the snow from the hydrant in your neighborhood you can contact the Fire Department at 712-732-8010 to let them know the location of the hydrant, and firemen or City crews will remove the snow.



- Parents are encouraged to talk to children about snow plow safety. Children should stay away from snow piled at the curb and be warned not to build forts in the piles. The force of snow coming off a plow can bury a fort and harm a child. Children should also be taught to stay at least 20 feet back in the driveway when a plow comes down the street.

- Be careful when driving and keep a safe distance when following a snow plow. Use extreme caution when passing plowing or de-icing equipment. It is difficult for operators to see directly behind their equipment.

Winterize your home:



- Insulate pipes - Insulation of exposed and uninsulated pipes is a simple process and can be critical. Don't forget to insulate hose bibs

- Clean out gutters and repair roof leaks

- Know where your shut-off valve is located and how to turn it off.

- In the event of a freeze or a flood, turning off this valve may be the best thing to do.

The stream of water trick - If temperatures are forecast to dip below 32 degrees, run a very thin stream of water from faucets and/or fixtures that may be susceptible to freezing.

- Open cabinet doors - If any of your plumbing fixtures are located adjacent to an exterior wall and inside of a cabinet, such as a kitchen or bathroom sink, open the cabinet doors to take advantage of room heat to help your pipes keep warm.
