**The City of Storm Lake would like to remind property owners that City Ordinance requires that all sidewalks be cleared of ice/snow within 72 hours of a snow fall, or the City can issue a municipal infraction for each day that the snow or ice is not removed. Please help keep our pedestrian pathways safe by removing snow and ice immediately following a snow or ice event.**



## SNOW EMERGENCY INFORMATION

During declared SNOW EMERGENCIES, cars left parked on City streets and in City parking lots designated for NO overnight parking will be ticketed and towed to provide for snow removal.
